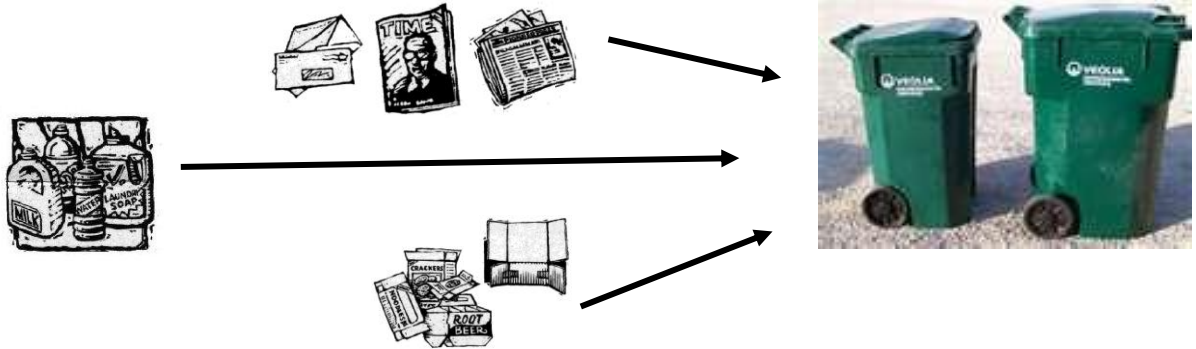


# WINONA COUNTY'S NEW NO-SORT RECYCLING



**New "No Sort" Recycling - all bottles, cans, newspapers, mail, magazines and boxes go together!**



## Containers

- Glass bottles & jars—Clean and remove lids
- Tin & aluminum cans—Clean, flatten if preferred
- ⊘ **No dishes, drinking glasses or window glass**



## Plastics

- All #1 & #2 plastics are now recyclable – Clean & remove caps & lids

Look for a  or a  on the container. We want these!

This means margarine & cool whip tubs, some yogurt containers, TV dinner trays, and even some single-serve take-out containers are recyclable.

Other numbers  through  are NOT recyclable. Trash them!



- ⊘ **No plastic bags**—they are a big problem in the new mechanical sorting process

## Paper & Magazines

- Mail, office & school paper
- Magazines & catalogs
- Newspapers & inserts
- Phone books



## Boxes

- Cereal, cracker, pasta, cake mix, tissue & pop carriers
- Cardboard boxes—Break down flat



**Guideline for Recycling Food Boxes:** If the product is stored in a cupboard, the box is recyclable. If the food box contains food that must be stored in the fridge or freezer, it is NOT recyclable.
