

WINONA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 1

The County Board of Winona County ordains:

No person shall enter or be within the boundaries of the Farmers Community Park between the hours of 11 p.m. and 4 a.m. of the following day unless such person has a camp in the park which has been authorized and approved in writing by the President of the Farmers Community Park Board. Farmers Community Park is that area within the limits of the County of Winona bounded as follows: On the west by the right of way of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company; on the North by County Highway 120; on the East by Warren Township Road 12 running North and South and intersecting said County Highway 120 on the North side; and on the South by the South line of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of said section eight (8), township one hundred and six (106) north, of range eight (8), containing 27.50 acres, more or less.

Violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$300 or imprisonment for not more than ninety days or both.

The County Board of Winona County ordains:

Violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$300 or imprisonment for not more than ninety days or both.

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

..... R. L. Andraschko being duly sworn, on oath, says he is and during all the times herein stated has been foreman of the printer and the printer in charge of the Winona Daily News and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows:

(1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches.

(2) Said newspaper is a daily and is distributed at least six days each week, or five days in a week in which a legal holiday is included.

(3) Said newspaper has twenty-five percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements.

(4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of a least seventy-five percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local Post Office.

(5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Winona in the County of Winona and it has its known office of issue in the City of Winona in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed.

(6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the Minnesota Historical Society.

(7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below.

(8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed notice hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for three successive weeks.

That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Friday the 1st day of October 19 76 and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Friday thereafter until and including Friday the 15th day of October 19 76
