

The County Board of Winona County ordains:

No person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, at any time at the following location on Winona County State Aid Highway No. 32:

On the South side of County State Aid Highway No. 32 in the City of Winona, Minnesota, beginning 400 feet west of the center line of Clarks Lane; thence Easterly for 675 feet and there terminating.

On the North side of County State Aid Highway No. 32 in the City of Winona, Minnesota, beginning 35 feet East of the center line of Hilbert Street, thence Westerly 1265 feet and there terminating.

As a means of notifying the public of the provisions of this ordinance the Winona County Highway Engineer is authorized and directed to paint and erect signs as per the standards on painting and the erection of signs which are contained in the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices.


It is a petty misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 for any person to violate any provisions of this ordinance. A person charged with a violation of this ordinance is not entitled to a jury trial, but shall be tried by a judge without a jury. If convicted, he is not subject to imprisonment but may be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00.

In addition, a peace officer is hereby authorized to move a vehicle to any public garage or other place of safety at the expense of the driver or owner or other person in charge of the vehicle when the vehicle has been parked or left standing in violation of this ordinance. A vehicle so removed shall be released to the driver or owner or other person in charge of the vehicle only upon the payment of any reasonable charges made for towing and storage.

In re: No parking ordinances  
dealing with C.S.A.H. Nos. 32,  
15 and 17

Dear Catherine, Don & Earl:

The County has decided to prohibit parking in certain areas of the above captioned County State Aid Highways.

In that connection, I enclose with Catherine's copy of this letter the original "Notice of Intention to Enact Ordinances". Catherine, would you please make arrangements to have that notice published in the newspaper as soon as possible in that the Board of County Commissioners will consider this on the 17th of November at 11 A.M. and there has to be at least a 10 day notice given to the public.

For each of you I enclose copies of the proposed ordinances. You will note that there are 3 ordinances in that we are dealing with 3 separates County State Aid Highways. Don is receiving the original proposed ordinances in that he will be presenting them to the Winona County Board.


I will be in trial on November 17th, 1981 and therefore will be unable to attend the meeting. This should present no problem in that I see no need for an attorney at that point.

However, I do think that Earl should be there in the event that there are any questions and assume Earl that you will in fact be there.

Since there are so many of us working on this, I think it should be said that I will assume that Catherine will make sure that the provisions of Minn. Stat. 375.51 Subd. 2 and Subd. 3 relating to publication of the Notice of Intention and publication of the Ordinances are complied with.
