If at any time during the year you produce more than this amount of hazardous waste, different rules and regulations apply. Minnesota Law requires that each generator register with MPCA and have a Generator ID Number. Licensing information and forms are available by calling the Winona County Household Hazardous Waste Program at 457-6462. We will verify your status with the MPCA. Winona County reserves the right to require additional analysis or repacking of wastes (at generator's expense) prior to drop off and to refuse to accept any wastes which are not pre-registered and approved. Completion of this and other forms does not expressly imply that the wastes listed on the attached inventory will be accepted. You are responsible for the safe and legal transportation of waste to the collection site. Disposal costs are subject to change without notice.
